[9 sts worked] Row 2 and 4: Stop mid-row, turn and knit back. Note: there is no need to use a stitch holder for such a small project, simply ignore the remaining stitches and leave them on the needle. Row 3: ssk, K3, k2tog. Row 5: ssk, K1, k2tog. Cast off. 3. Rejoin yarn to ... Knit a quick heart | LoveCrafts Start by knitting the top of the heart – cast on 5 stitches. Row 1: Knit. Row 2: Increase the first first stitch by knitting in the front and back (kfb) of the stitch, then knit to the end of the row. Gauge - Don't worry too much about gauge for this pattern. The gauge of the heart I made is 6 sts/ 4 rows in 1 inch.
